



Seasonally Adjusted








Idaho's Nonfarm Jobs by Region

Seasonally Adjusted One Year Change, February 2017







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Key Growth Industries 2-Yr. Job Increase: 2016^{Q1}-2018^{Q1}







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Long Term Projections

Projected 2014-2024 Net Growth in Thousands









Percentage Change 2006 to 2016^{Dec.}




Employment Growth: Northern Idaho

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



Regional Job Growth: 2014 – 2024


2014 Employment and Projected 2024 Employment in thousands






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The size of the bubble indicates population density





IDAHO Idaho Micro-Counties vs. Rest of Idaho



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

Idaho Micro-Counties vs. Rest of Idaho Employment Change 2006-2016






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Idaho Population Growth



Causes of Death for White Males


Mortality Rates for White Males, Age 45-54

Routine Jobs Employment growth rates by complexity class



Growth in Non-Routine Jobs


